

Recommended Uniform Screening Panel


- Should states screen for diseases not on the RUSP?

Continuing to Expand NBS in MO

- May 2016 SCID Legislation Passed
- December 2016 Filed HB 66 SMA & MPS II
- SB 50 signed into Law July 20, 2017
- 2019 Missouri is screening for SMA & MPS II
- Site Visits from around US, the world, and CDC continue in MO

Where Does the Advocate Start?

- Research
 - What does your state currently screen for?
 - How is NBS funded in your state?
 - How many live birth are there in your state?
- Your Legislator (Rep or Senator)
- State Health Lab
- Genetics Advisory Committee
- Other Groups

Motivation/Roadblocks

- What are the benefits of screening?
- Why do we need legislation?
- Who will this affect? Put a face to the dollar signs!
- Make it personal
- Palliative Care vs Screening Costs
- You are MORE POWERFUL than you know!
