
THE ROLE OF A REGISTERED DIETITIAN NUTRITIONIST (RDN)

WHERE CAN RDNS HELP? 1,2

- PEDIATRIC FEEDING DISORDERS (PFD)
- PARENT FRUSTRATION OR DISTRESS WITH FEEDING OR MEAL TIMES
- GROWTH BELOW THE 5TH PERCENTILE, ABOVE THE 85TH PERCENTILE, CROSSING MULTIPLE PERCENTILES
- NEED FOR CO-MANAGEMENT OF ENTERAL NUTRITION (NG TUBE, PEG TUBE, PEG-J TUBE)
- DELAYED DEVELOPMENT OR ORAL MOTOR ORAL AND SELF-FEEDING
- DIFFICULTY WEANING FROM BREASTFEEDING
- GENETIC OR CHROMOSOMAL ABNORMALITIES
- ACQUIRED BRAIN IMPAIRMENT
- NEURODEVELOPMENTAL DISORDERS
- GENERAL PROGRESSION WITH FOOD
- TYPICAL FEEDING DEVELOPMENT AND SKILLS
- PREMATURE BIRTH (<37 WEEKS GESTATION)

REQUIREMENTS TO BECOME AN RDN 4



- BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM AN ACCREDITED UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE OR FOREIGN EQUIVALENT.
- COURSEWORK THROUGH AN ACCREDITATION COUNSEL FOR EDUCATION IN NUTRITION AND DIETETICS (ACEND) ACCREDITED DIDACTIC PROGRAM (DPD) OR COORDINATED PROGRAM IN DIETETICS (CP).
- A MINIMUM OF 1000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED PRACTICE THROUGH AN ACEND ACCREDITED DIETETIC INTERNSHIP.
- PASS A NATIONALLY EXAMINATION ADMINISTERED BY THE COMMISSION OF DIETETIC REGISTRATION (CDR).
