




What is the Rock Report?

State Team Funding Deadlines for Year 6 Applications OPEN: July 1st Applications CLOSE: September 30th • Up to \$2000 can be requested per state team. If no application is received by September 30th, the state funds will be donated to the cross pollination fund. Application link will be shared at July state team meetings and with the co-leads.

- Open to anyone in our 8 state region who has a project idea to improve access to genetic services.
- Priority given to projects that cross-pollinate between 2 or more states in our region.
