





Most states only have 1 genetics center.




This is an ongoing focus in our region and nation wide.

EDS Algorithm




EDS Algorithm
Launched July 2020

- EDS stands for Ehlers
 Danlos Syndrome
- This algorithm is for primary care and pediatric providers

Algorithm for diagnosis, management, and referral

This algorithm serves as a quick reference on how to approach JHS/hEDS. Each step (blue boxes) links to a more detailed description in this guide (rectangles). It is based on the 2017 diagnostic criteria for JHS/hEDS (Malfait et al. 2017).
