



Do you have concerns about your child? Below are red flags or warning signs and symptoms that were self-reported by families whose child went on to receive a genetic diagnosis. 89% of reported red flags were noted before 4 years of age.





 Physical/motor delay (not rolling over, crawling or walking)

Cleft palate

- Speech (not babbling or responding to name) others, not smiling)
- Cognitive (unable to or not interested in play)
- Social/emotional (difficulty interacting with
- Adaptive (coordination of hands and fingers) Loss of any milestone (regression)

Physical Features

Feeding Issues

Behavior

- Extra fingers or toes
 - Large/small head size (macrocephaly/microcephaly)
 - Short/tall height (stature)
- Difficulty swallowing
- Struggles with breastfeeding
- Feeding tube dependent

- Never feeling full
- Poor appetite
- Vomiting
- Gagging on food



• Facial feature differences (small chin, wide forehea

• Frequent joint dislocations (hip dysplasia)

- Difficulty in school or social settings
- ADHD/impulsive or hyperactive behavior
- Easily distracted

Muscle weakness

Body is floppy

• High pitched cry/tone of voice







Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

Repetitive movements

Constantly upset or crying

- Fatigues quickly when active
- Weight or rate of weight gain being much lower than that of other children




Seizures


- Floppy or low muscle tone (hypotonia)
- Stiff or high muscle tone (hypertonia)
- · Baby not attempting to roll over or hold head up when on tummy
- Headaches/migraines
- Neurological concerns
- · Pulmonary/cardiac concerns
- Gl issues (reflux/bowel concerns)
- · Hearing/vision concerns · Bruising
- Immune issues




