This funding opportunity will prioritize submissions where individuals from 2 or more of the states in our region are collaborating together on a project...since the focus is cross-pollination in our region!


The application opened July 1, 2022 and can be found here.


This funding is separate from state team funding, so please utilize the state team funding application for any state team specific project requests first.
