About MSRGN

<u>The Mountain States Regional Genetics Network (MSRGN)</u> is a federally funded network comprised of members from 8 states (AZ, CO, MT, NV, NM, TX, UT, WY) with a shared mission to increase access to genetics services in our region.

We ensure that individuals with genetic disorders and their families have access to quality care and appropriate genetic expertise and information through facilitating a professional network of genetics clinics, key primary care practices, consumer advocates, and state health department resources.

The MSRGN is one of seven regional networks funded through the Healthcare Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). The MSRGN is focused on the following priorities:

- linkage of medically underserved populations to genetic services;
- implementation of quality improvement activities to increase genetic services;
- implementation of evidence-based innovative models of telehealth/telemedicine focused on clinical genetics;
- provision of resources to providers (genetics and primary care), public health professionals, and individuals with genetics conditions and their families.



About the MSRGN Annual Genetics Summit

The MSRGN Annual Genetics Summit aims to educate, engage, and connect families, providers, and public health professionals around contemporary topics in genetics, with a focus on the following objectives:

- Identify the most recent medical knowledge and state, regional, and national initiatives in the field of the pediatric genetic services.
- Describe genetics topics such as clinical best practices, health care policy, reaching underserved populations, and telegenetics.
- Identify available resources and enable networking across regional stakeholders to increase access to genetic services, especially to underserved populations.

While the work of MSRGN is primarily done within our 8 member states, the annual virtual summit draws hundreds of participants from across the nation.

The 2023 MSRGN Summit is being held virtually on October 11-12, 2023 from 10:30am – 4:30pm CDT. The theme for the 2023 summit is "PEAK Performance," with presentations focusing on:

- Primary Care & Genetics
- Emotional Perspectives of Genetics
- Access to Genetics Care for Underserved Populations
- Karyotypes to Knockouts (Genetic Testing & Research)
