

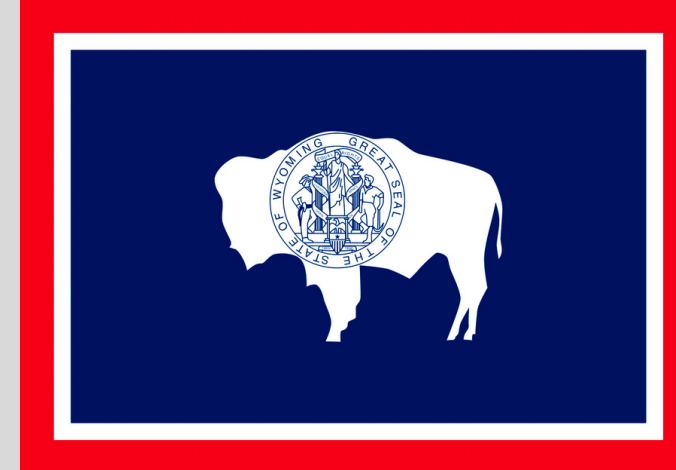

## Distribution of Where is Bear? books

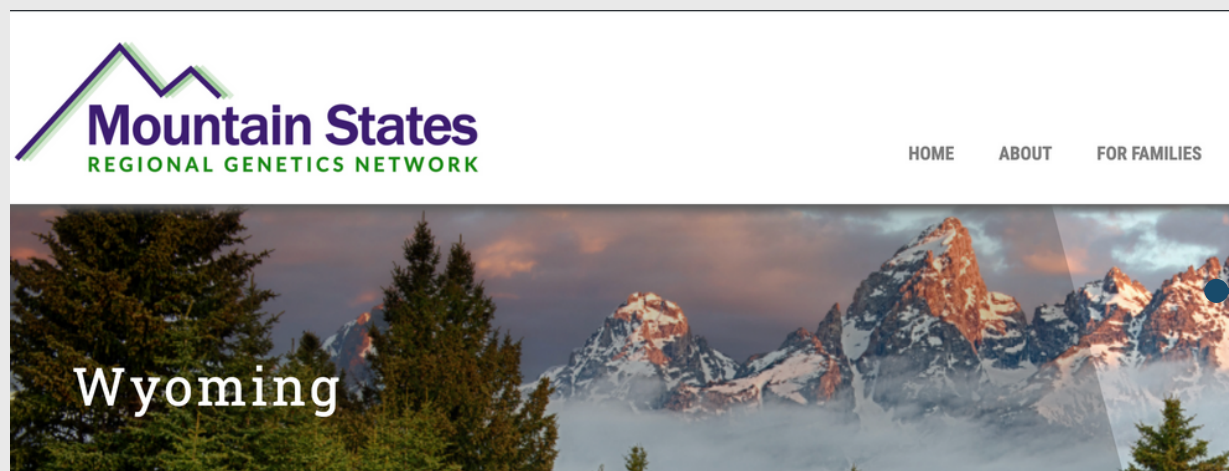
Carleigh, the Wyoming state team co-lead, compiled a list of nurses, nurse practitioners and pediatric clinics in Wyoming and mailed the books to them.

The Wyoming team updated their webpage on the MSRGN website in 2022 to feature the Where is Bear? book.

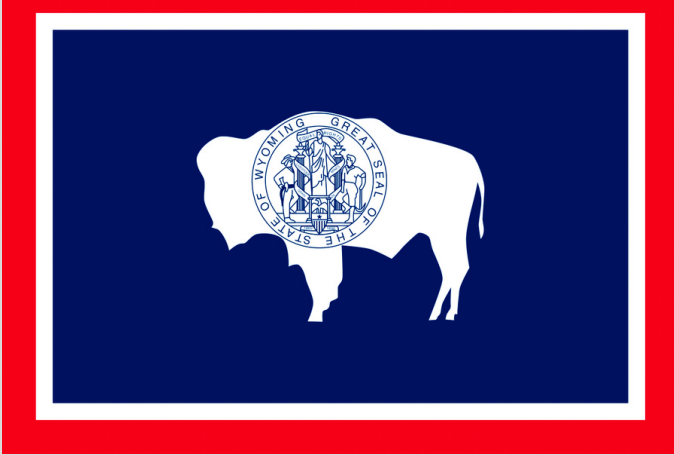
## Momentum...stay tuned

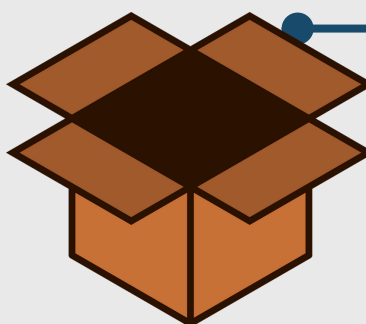


## Year 6: 2022-2023

The Wyoming team distributed 276 packets of the information listed above.

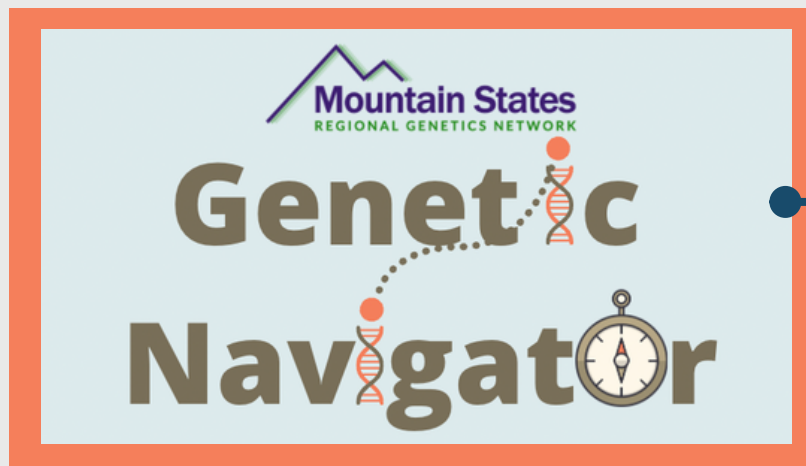


## Time 4 Genetics
