



## Healthcare Interpreter Training: Prenatal Genetics February 3 & 10, 2024 Reserve your seat today!

In collaboration with the <u>National Coordinating Center</u>, please join us for a FREE seven-hour virtual training (led by nationally recognized trainer Cynthia E. Roat, MPH) to help you better understand and more accurately interpret the information provided during a genetics appointment. To get the most out of the training, we ask that:
